## WHAT A YEAR. LOOKING AHEAD.



I feel like I am sitting on a high hill. I look back at the valley that represents last year, and I am amazed at all MEDIA Alliance has experienced. We have seen more countries added to our list of places where we serve Christian leaders who share the Gospel using today's media tools. Countries like Mongolia, Jordan, the Philippines, Morocco, Nepal, and Malaysia. Millions of people live in these countries, and most need Jesus as their Lord. What a year.

Then I read God's living Word. Isaiah 43, to be specific, as the Lord says:

*"But forget all that—  
it is nothing compared to what I am going to do.  
For I am about to do something new.  
See, I have already begun! Do you not see it?"*

What will the Lord do through MEDIA Alliance in 2026? In the words of that popular Christian song: "I can only imagine."

Some of the future we see now. A media training conference for the Middle East and North Africa is scheduled to take place in Jordan in early June 2026. A similar conference in Recife, Brazil aims to assist those ministries in the northeastern part of the huge country. And the International Media Leadership Summit will serve forty key Christian media leaders who come to Dallas for a week of inspiration, insight, training, and networking. Relationships are built, and leaders are encouraged to serve more creatively and effectively, sharing the hope of the Gospel.

I remember the words of an old hymn:

The whole world was lost in the darkness of sin;  
The light of the world is Jesus.

One missionary organization says, "The only solution to lostness is the Gospel." To that, I add the Scripture:

*"But how can they call on him to save them unless they believe in him? And how can they believe in him if they have never heard about him? And how can they hear about him unless someone tells them?" (Romans 10:14 NLT)*

So, what is that new thing God has in store? As the day of Christ's return approaches, I believe the Lord wants us to spread the hope of Jesus to the entire world. There is no more effective way than through the powerful media tools He has given us...combined with dedicated and trained media leaders who stand firm in their countries and often in hostile cultures.

# AROUND THE WORLD

A GLOBAL UPDATE

Sometimes, this past year felt like we were in the movie “Around the World in 80 Days.” Your MEDIA Alliance team was on the road and in the air, traveling around the world to serve Christian media leaders from South Africa to Indonesia, from Jordan to India, and beyond. Touching lives in dozens of countries. Your support and prayers have been the fuel for an incredible journey to share the Gospel with those who have never had the chance to hear.

It’s not just about the journey or even the destination. It’s about the people the Lord has serving Him through Christian media. MEDIA Alliance actively supports them in various ways—training, encouraging, challenging, and praying for these faithful servants who are on a mission to share Jesus with those in their cultures and countries.

Jordan and Morocco in the Middle East and North Africa face different challenges, but committed Christians are seeking ways to share God’s hope in innovative and expanding ways. Nabeeh and Ruba Abbassi in Jordan run strong ministries with connections to many people across the region. Their influence will be very helpful as MEDIA Alliance hosts media training in Jordan in June 2026.

While in South Africa to speak to the Association of Christian Media, we reconnected with our ministry partner Francois Botha. We stepped in to encourage Rozanne, a graphic artist who serves ministries and churches. Rozanne’s response to our encouragement: “I’ve never had such a spiritual father before, so it’s quite something to me.” Encouragement.

Meet Borogchingoo (Bogi) from Mongolia, Heman from Nepal, and Gerson from the Philippines. Your support helped us host the Asia Media Leadership Forum, giving these and others the chance to connect with peers from their region and grow in their media work: to share Jesus with those living in darkness. They were part of a group of media leaders from six countries across Asia, serving as God's ambassadors through media in difficult places.

The Malaysia Bible Seminary held its third Discipleship Conference in August and invited MEDIA Alliance to participate. Over two hundred attendees, both online and in person, were encouraged to use every available means, including media, to bring God's hope to a world that often feels hopeless.

In September, MEDIA Alliance gathered Christian media professionals from across the Balkans in Eastern Europe. It had been years since we last conducted media training in radio, church media, social media, and leadership in this region. Your support once again made a significant impact.



Our longtime friend Dr. Stoyko Petkoff, a Christian during the Communist era in Bulgaria, now leads Studio 865, producing Christian programming and distributing it to media outlets in that country. Our team of instructors from organizations like In Touch, Prestonwood Baptist Church, and Ambassador Advertising went beyond classroom instruction to personal interaction, continuing to empower these faithful servants.

The year of global travel ended with us back in the Middle East. SAT-7 is a remarkable ministry that reaches a vast region of the Middle East and North Africa. With four satellite television channels, they carry the Gospel to millions living in this key area. Programming in Turkish, Farsi, and Arabic brings Christian content to those living in what has been called the 10/40 window, one of the largest areas of unreached people in our world. Led by Rita El-Mounayer, SAT-7 is a dynamic and creative ministry that is intentional about taking Jesus to the people so that those living in darkness can see the Light of the world, Jesus.



# RESTORING SANITA

It has been referred to as the Silent Global Crisis: human trafficking. Many of the locations served by MEDIA Alliance rank high among offenders. But what can an individual do? It would be easy to overlook this issue.

Christian media in countries where the Gospel is challenged does well to daily proclaim God's Truth, teaching the power of God's Word to new believers and to those who have never heard. But most media leaders are looking for ways the Gospel can impact in their communities and their culture.

These dedicated servants don't ignore issues like human trafficking, or other key cultural concerns. They want to shine God's light into the darkness.

Case in point: Neelima Koirala (featured on the cover) and the radio ministry she leads in Kathmandu, Nepal. This new partner with MEDIA Alliance became part of a story involving the trafficking of a young girl from Nepal to India. Sanita, at age 17, was taken to India and forced into modern-day slavery. Finally, a rescue group found Sanita and brought her back to Nepal.

By the time Sanita made it back to Kathmandu,

she had no idea where her family was. Five long and horrific years had passed. She remained separated from those she loved. Sanita had no way to find her mother, father, or other family members. Who could help her?

Hearts were touched by Sanita's story. A Christian radio station was contacted. But what could this station do? Neelima's team at Kingdom Voice FM invited Sanita to their studios and recorded an emotional interview. Neelima and her staff were praying that, somehow, the video they recorded

and uploaded to YouTube would be seen by Sanita's family. The Lord answered their prayers.

When asked why Kingdom Voice FM, a radio station, would step out and record a video that had such a small chance at helping bring this family back together, Neelima replied, "We did this interview because this is our calling—to use media as a tool to bring hope, rescue, and salvation into someone's life."

Soon, the Kingdom Voice FM team accompanied Sanita on a three-hour trip to her home village and had the joy of capturing the heartfelt reunion of Sanita and her family. A young girl was rescued. A family was reunited. Faith was restored. All because someone went above and beyond what was expected.

The dedicated leaders of our MEDIA Alliance family often exceed expectations. They look for ways to transform the culture and bring God's hope to their spheres of influence. And through your faithful support, you become part of inspiring stories like this. Pray for the work in Nepal and for

leaders like Neelima and others who are making a difference as they shine the Light of Jesus into their world.

Average cost of \$1,600 per participant.

Partnering to provide in-country media training for one hundred attendees. We're planning for two in 2026.

**\$50,000 each**

Average cost of \$500 per participant.

## Studio Expansion

Further extending use of our video studio to enhance overall training.

**\$40,000 total**

Provides additional sets, lighting, and video options.
